## ***Christmas Bazaar - Friday 1<sup>st</sup> December at 3pm***

The school hall will again be filled with a festive collection of stalls selling cakes, sweets, seasonal goods, stocking fillers and craft items. Santa Claus will be waiting to see the children in his grotto and there will be tombola games for adults, boys and girls as well as the legendary chocolate tombola, where every prize is guaranteed to be... chocolate!

The winning tickets for the 'rainbow raffle' are drawn and the grown-ups can try their luck at winning some 'seasonal drinks'. The FOSS will be selling hot dogs, soft drinks and crisps from the school kitchen.

Doors open at 3pm. Tickets to see Santa cost £1 each and will be on sale from the school office or at the bazaar on the day. To avoid long queues the children will be called in small groups, look out for Santa's helper who will help this run smoothly. Please bring small change if you can.
