

## Reminders and dates for your diary.....

- ✓ School reopens on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> November.
- ✓ Monday 31<sup>st</sup> October is a Teacher Training Day. No children that day please!!!!

In general clubs do not run the first and last week of any term. We find the children get too tired and it also provides staff with the chance to meet after school! Early Birds and Night Owls **DO** run during these weeks.
