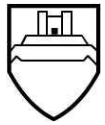

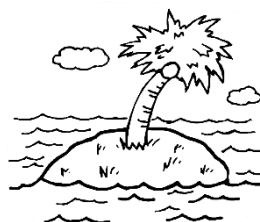
Whole School Topic Day: Tuesday 18th July 2017 (TOMORROW)
