### Life Education Centre. Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> and Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> January 2017

**The Life Education Centre (a bus which visits us every year) is** part of a national charity called Coram Life Education and is the UK 's largest children's health education charity, providing a comprehensive range of high quality and evidence-based services appropriate to the needs of primary school children.

Our school is receiving a visit by the Mobile Classroom of the Life Education Centre on **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> January and Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> January.** Life Education Centre (Wiltshire) Ltd is a local charity affiliated to the national charity. It is supported by the Education, Health and Police authorities and administered by a small team of volunteers from local Rotary Clubs. It provides a unique programme which teaches children about the wonder of their bodies, how to take care of them, and how relationships, food, drink, drugs and other substances can affect them.

The specially equipped mobile classroom provides an unforgettable experience for the children, which assists our school in our health education work. The focused, interactive, programmes are designed and varied to match each age group and are presented by a specialist educator. Each class will spend about an hour with the LEC teacher.

The school is charged about  $\pounds4.00$  (per child) for these visits. The school and the PTA contribute towards the cost, but a donation of  $\pounds1$  per child would really help the funds to go further. Please drop donations off at the school office. Many **thanks**.
