We are encouraging children to bring in non-perishables during the week commencing Monday 2nd October. As usual all our *Harvest Gifts* will go to the Trussell Trust. This organisation brings a bit of hope to families who are going through a tough time.

THE FOOD BANK provides short term emergency food to people in crisis. Food is given as an intervention strategy which allows care professionals, such as Church Pastoral Workers, Health Visitors, Social Services etc, time to put longer term measures in place. People are given enough food for 3 days. **THE FOOD BANK** also provides bulk food for other charities to provide cooked meals for people.
