You may have heard lots of discussion in the news about the formula for funding schools and how some schools stand to win and some to lose. We stand to gain. Next year it is proposed that we be funded £2,998 per pupil, which is an increase of 8.85%. As you can see it is important to us that funding is recalculated.
