

Home Learning (Home work)

Thank you to everyone who returned the questionnaires about home learning to school at the end of last term. Over the holidays Mrs. Williams kindly gathered in all the sheets and collated the information for us. The teachers will be discussing the outcomes and also adding their thoughts about 'home learning' at the staff meeting on Thursday. The beginning of the new academic year provides us with a good opportunity to take stock and think about what we do and why we do it!

Pupils will not receive any written home learning this week. Instead they will be expected to read and write a comment in their Reading Record. More info on home learning to follow!

<u>Swimming</u> commences on Tuesday 13th September. This year swimming lessons will be for Year 4 and Year 5. The children will be transported from school to the Five Rivers Leisure Centre by coach on a Tuesday afternoon. They will return in time for the end of the school day. Unfortunately due to budget constraints the lessons will only run from 13th September until 6th December this year. The voluntary contribution will remain at £2 per session. This does not cover the entire cost of lessons but goes some way to covering the cost of the coach hire, swimming teachers, life guards and the hire of the swimming pool. Private swimming lessons are very expensive, so I hope you agree this still represents good value for money. A separate letter will go out to Y4 and Y5 giving more detail about swimming. Please be aware of the coach returning to school at 3pm!
