If you have a <u>Key Worker in your HOUSEHOLD</u> and you requested a place on Monday 23.03.20, for your child, so that you can help to keep the country running, please be advised that <u>your child will have a place in school on Monday</u> and for the rest of the week.

Mrs Watkins and I have not made any judgements regarding the role that people fulfil and we are trusting all of you to be honest and open with us. Should staffing become an issue at any point, we may have to prioritise certain jobs. This could be as early as next week, who knows!

Schools have been asked to remain open for some pupils, in order to allow key workers to function. We have also been asked to close to others, so that risks are minimised. This has been an incredibly painful process, as we want to have everyone back as usual. If you absolutely don't need full time care please let us know. This will really help!
