ParentPay

As you know this academic year, we launched a new system ParentPay, which allows you to pay for uniform, school meals, trips, swimming and Early Birds / Night Owls electronically. Thank you for using this facility and I hope the system works for you 'at your end'! Please understand that this is not a booking system just a payment system another way of paying PROMPTLY instead of cash.

From 'our end' you need to know that Mrs Thornton in the school office has to adjust the system manually and she does this once a week, usually on a Monday. Please pay for things as you use / want them rather than allowing a large bill to mount up. This is not a credit system.

Please pay for your school meals in advance. If meals are not paid for, we will lose the service. The meals service has never been in such a state of arrears. Please help us to keep everything running smoothly!

Please pay PROMPTLY, as you did when using old fashioned cash. Thank you.

Early Birds and Night Owls

Please note that on the last day of term (Friday 21st December) Early Birds <u>does take place</u>, but there is <u>no</u> Night Owls after school.
