Who can enter: open to young people up to and including 16 years old on 1st April 2020

The challenge: to make a picture with the subject relating to the work of the Royal National Lifeboat Institution (RNLI), the charity saving lives at sea since 1854.

Specification: the picture must be on a sheet of A4 paper using any medium of choice (watercolour, crayon, oil or any other art form). Entries are free but must be mailed by Royal Mail and be accompanied by a completed the entry form. They may also be scanned and emailed to us.

Classes

Class A open to Children under 7 years old on 1st April 2020.

Class B open to Children between 7 years old and under 12 years old on 1st April 2020.

Class C open to Children 12 years to 16 years old on 1st April 2020.

Additional Special Class Z open to all up to 16 years old on 1st April 2020.

The same challenge as above except to create a computer-generated image, print it on paper and email it in.

RULES

- i) **Entry is free** but **Donations** to the RNLI would be most welcome. One entry per person for A B C Classes plus an additional entry in Class Z
- ii) Entries must be marked with competitor's name and class and be accompanied by the entry form completed and signed by parent or guardian
- iii) Entries to be sent by post or scanned and emailed, see entry form.
- iv) Closing date for entries 23.59 hours Monday 18th May. Any mail received with a postmark of 18th May in UK will be accepted as a valid entry.
- v) The Judges' decision is final no correspondence will be entered into on these decisions
- vi) A number of Prizes will be awarded for each class. In addition the 1st prize winners in all classes will be invited to a special celebration visit to Mudeford Lifeboat Station our linked station. This will be at a time to be arranged when coronavirus restrictions are lifted and life returns to normal.
- vii) We are unable to return any of the work entered. If you send a scan or copy we may request to see the original before completing the judging.
- viii) A tie break question has been added "What do you most like about the RNLI"
