## Create a Volcano Artwork

This is a collage/painting by an artist called Margaret Godfrey. Can you create a volcano artwork? She has stuck down strips of scrunched tissue to create texture and then painted over it.



If you make your paint watery you can dab it on and then blow through a straw to make the lava eruption! When it's dry you can always draw extra details like boulders in.

## Make your own Volcano Model

Use this recipe to make the salt dough, you will need to times the recipe by 6 so that you have enough dough.

Once you have mixed the dough make it into a volcano shape on a baking tray. Carefully make a hole in the centre and pinch around the top edge to make it volcano shaped. Leave on a sunny window sill to dry out or on a very low heat in the oven until it goes hard. Once it is pretty hard and dried out you can paint it? Start with the red and yellow lava and then carefully add the grey rock around it.

Today the volcano has finally blown! As I arrived I could see....


