Year 5/6 Residential Trip to Braeside: Monday 13th – Wednesday 15th June 2022.

Kit List

All bedding is provided at the centre (please encourage your child to practise putting on a duvet cover).

For the trip, your child will need:

- indoor shoes (slippers or clean trainers)
- outdoor shoes (something you don't mind getting muddy and can walk in)
- socks
- underwear
- waterproof coat
- trousers
- nightwear
- towel and a wash bag (e.g. toothbrush, toothpaste, hair brush (NO SPRAYS e.g. deodorant please)
