- · Doctors kept him alive on a life-support machine.
- · There is a vending machine on the platform that dispenses snacks.
- The machine emits a high-pitched sound when you press the button.
- · This sewing machine is operated by a foot pedal.
- · I need some coins for the ticket machine in the car park.
