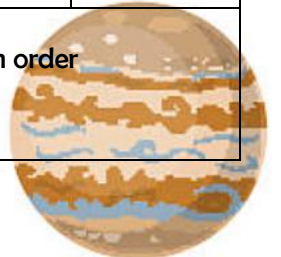


Counting & Number Bonds	Home	Home	School
