All bedding is provided at the centre (please encourage your child to practise putting on a duvet cover).

- indoor shoes (*slippers or clean trainers*)
- outdoor shoes (*something you don't mind getting muddy and can walk in*)
- socks
- underwear
- waterproof coat
- trousers
- nightwear
- towel and a wash bag – (e.g. toothbrush, toothpaste, hair brush (NO SPRAYS – e.g. deodorant please))
- shirts (many thin layers!)
