In Butterfly and Owl Classes, the theme was 'Nature in Mathematics' where they explored leaf symmetry, measuring with branches & leaves, pattern making and creating pictograms of different leaf colours.

In Robin, Woodpecker and Fox Classes, the theme was 'Stars of Mathematics'. The children learnt about famous mathematicians such as Ava Lovelace, Alan Turing, Katherine Johnson and Al-Khwarizmi.
