### Jolly Jar Tombola

A Jolly Jar is a **creatively decorated jar** filled with a variety of fun items that will be sold on our Jolly Jar Tombola. You can fill your Jar with anything. Jars in previous years have been filled with teabags, sweets, paperclips, cookie ingredients. The options are endless. You then decorate the jar however you like.



### RAINBOW RAFFLE

The Rainbow Raffle is where we raffle off hampers that are made up of items of a specific colour.

Each class is allocated a colour. To build the hampers, we ask you to bring in something of that colour. So, if your class is given red you can bring in anything red i.e.: red wine, Santa, Tinsel, Baubles, Shower gel, Bath Bombs, Maltesers. Anything of that colour, but we would ask that items are in date, new or nearly new.
