

Children's Mental Health Awareness Week – w/b Monday 4th March 2024

During the week, we will be recognising Children's Mental Health. The children will be carrying out age appropriate activities in their classes. These will help them recognise and understand what mental health concerns are and to learn strategies to be able to deal with these. This will support the learning the children do in our PSHE curriculum throughout the school year. On Monday 4th March, each class will have an Emergency Awareness Training session delivered by Wiltshire Air Ambulance. This is an interactive training session for children at primary schools, which delivers a range of lifesaving skills. The content is age appropriate with the sessions lasting between 30 and 90 minutes. All children, who take part, will receive a certificate of attendance. The content for each year group is as follows:

Butterfly Class	Making a 999 call/How to get help when someone is unwell
Owl Class	Making a 999 call and Recovery Position
Robin Class	Making a 999 call, Recovery Position and CPR
Woodpecker Class	Making a 999 call, Recovery Position, CPR, AED use and Choking
Fox Class	Making a 999 call, Recovery Position, CPR, AED use, Choking and Bleeding

A Few reminders

Children are allowed to bring a snack and water bottle into school, children can refill their bottles throughout the day from the taps. Water bottles should have a sports cap and be filled with water. This means they do not spill when knocked over and do not make everything sticky. We allow the children to drink throughout the day whenever they are thirsty. Bottles with screw tops are not suitable.

Please do not provide your child with nuts for their snack or packed lunch as we do have children with nut allergies.

Also because we have so many children, with allergies and dietary needs we are <u>unable</u> to allow birthday cakes or sweets in school to give to others.
