On **Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> September** Fox Class will have a visit into Salisbury. In RE, we are learning about art and architecture in different places of worship so it will be an opportunity for the children to compare different places of worship. First, we will visit **Emmanuel Church** (reformed evangelical church). After a snack break at this church, we will then walk to **The Quaker Meeting House** for a visit. We will then walk to **St Thomas's Church** for a quick visit and lunch. After that, we will make our way to **Salisbury Library** for a tour of the library and an opportunity to browse the shelves! A very busy day!

If your child has their own library card, they can bring it along with them to borrow any books. If your child does not have their own library card, please complete the attached application form for library membership and return it to school via the drop box by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September. I will pass on the forms to the library so that your child has a card ready for them on the day of the trip.

We shall leave school on foot at 09:15 and arrive at Emmanuel Church for 10:15. We shall return to school by 15:15. Your child will need a **packed lunch, some extra snacks** and a **water bottle** that they are able to carry in a **backpack**. If your child is eligible for a free school meal a packed lunch will be provided by the kitchen. We are hoping for good weather, but please make sure your child has a **waterproof coat and suitable shoes**. As we are walking, if the weather is too wet, we may need to postpone the trip.
