On **Tuesday 8th October** Owl Class will visit Salisbury Cathedral for the day. We are learning about the Cathedral as a part of our History topic. The day will include a tour of the Cathedral, as well as a drama workshop to retell the story of the Cathedral being moved from Old Sarum to where it is today, and a stained-glass window art activity.

We will leave school at 9:00am and we will return at 3:00pm, in time for the end of the day, travelling by coach.
