

#### **Pupil Premium Grant**

All infant school children, those in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 have been entitled to free school meals since September 2014. They are also provided with a daily healthy snack.

IN ADDITION, a Pupil Premium Grant will be given to the school for children whose parents are in receipt of the following 'support' payments:

- Income Support
- Job Seeker's Allowance (income-based)
- Employment and Support Allowance (income-related)
- support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit providing you are NOT entitled to Working Tax Credit and your family's annual income (as assessed by HMRC) is not more than £16,190.
- Working Tax Credit 'run-on' the payment you may receive for a further four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)

If you are receiving qualifying benefits (listed above), the government will give our school a Pupil Premium of £1,515 for primary-aged pupils (2025-2026).

#### Also....

**Hair:** Long hair must be tied back for health and safety reasons. This is essential during PE lessons but is encouraged in all activities.

**Jewellery:** Pupils may wear watches and one small pair of studs for pierced ears (in ear lobes only). No other jewellery is allowed. In order to comply with L.A. Health and Safety guidelines, pupils are required to remove watches and earrings for PE activities. If children cannot remove them, they are asked to cover them with tape.

**Make-up:** The Governors believe that any form of make-up or hair colouring is inappropriate for this age group. Nail varnish may not be worn.

#### **Attendance**

I am very proud of the children's attendance at Stratford school. Last year, 2024-2025 we had an average attendance of just above 96%, which again was above the national average of 94.8%

In August 2024 the Department of Education brought in new statutory for attendance in schools and as a Local Authority school we are advised to follow them.

The major change was regarding term time holidays. The guidelines state that:

Pupils should not be taken out of school during term time unless it is unavoidable. Generally, a need or desire for a holiday or other absence for the purpose of leisure and recreation would not constitute an exceptional circumstance. The guidance is clear that headteachers should not be considering a holiday as an exceptional circumstance.

Our local authority's Education Welfare Department has summarised the guidance and explained the changes in the attachment to this letter. Please read carefully and if you have any questions please ask.

#### Children being picked up by other adults

To allow your child to be picked up by an adult other than one with parental responsibility, (including when they might be having a playdate) please send an email to the school Office address with 'Going Home' in the subject box.

#### Walking home independently

If you give permission for your child to walk from school on their own, either to the car, the Reading Rooms or home, please send an email to the school Office address (admin@stratford-subcastle.wilts.sch.uk) with the title "Walking Home Permission" along with your child's name and Class in the subject line.

Within the email please state:

- that you give your permission for your child to Walk or Cycle home at the end of the day
- which days you give your permission for your child to Walk or Cycle home at the end of the day;

<u>Please note this is an annual update, so for Year 6 children even if you gave permission last year you will need to do so again for the new school year.</u>

#### **Mobile phones**

Those children that do walk home independently are allowed to bring a mobile phone into school which they can use on their journey to and from school. Children hand their phones into their Class Teacher. These are then locked away until the end of the day.

There are no circumstances where it is acceptable for a child to have their mobile phone with them during the school day. The children must switch their phones off on arrival at the school gate and they can be switched back on again once they have left the school premises at the end of the day.

If your child does not walk home then there is no reason for them to have a mobile phone in school.

#### **Packed Lunches**

Can I remind you all that we are a nut-free school and this also including products that contain nuts. Please check the labelling of foods carefully as we do have several children who have a nut allergy, who have Epi-pens and having nuts in school could cause a life threatening event.

#### And finally...

All clubs start this week. They will finish at 4:00pm, except for choir, on Thursday, which Mrs Aylett would like to run until 4.15pm. If this is a problem for you, please don't worry you can collect your child at 4.00pm.
