Here are some ideas

- Fossils: Learn how fossils are made and what they tell us about the past.
- Minibeasts: Investigate worms, ants, and other creatures that live underground.
- Caves and Tunnels: Learn how natural caves form and where famous ones are.
- Human-made structures: The London Underground, subways, and mines around the world.
- World War II bunkers and shelters: Life underground during the Blitz.
- Archaeology: How we discover ancient remains buried under the ground.
- Story writing: "A Journey Underground" adventure or mystery story.
- Diary entry: From the point of view of a miner, archaeologist, or even a worm!
- Use charcoal and earthy tones to create cave art.
- Design an underground city or home of the future.
- Use Scratch to animate an underground journey.
- Compose a soundscape of underground noises echoing drips, digging, trains rumbling.

You may wish to focus on one aspect or several. The choice is yours!



Be as creative with the theme as you like. You may create models, cook, draw or paint, take photographs or write a story or poem.

You MUST make sure that something is in your book as a record of your topic. This could be a photo of your work or you could write about what you did! However, you may also like to do the whole topic in your book, it is up to you!

Please ensure some writing is included as part of your topic in some way!
