Mrs Waters has arranged for Wiltshire and Bath Air Ambulance Charity to come into school, on **Monday 9th February 2026**, to deliver their Aware+ programme. As part of the PSHE curriculum, all schools should provide First Aid training to its pupils. The course content is matched to the age of the children and adapted for individual needs.

We recognise that children may have experience of first aid situations involving the emergency services and encourage you to let your child's school know if this is the case. All topics are covered sensitively and at an age-appropriate level.

Owl Class: Making a 999 call and recovery Position

Robin Class: Making a 999 call, recovery Position and CPR

Woodpecker Class: Making a 999 call, recovery Position, CPR, AED use and choking

Fox Class: Making a 999 call, recovery Position, CPR, AED use, choking and bleeding

This Safer Internet Day we are exploring the impact of AI on all of our lives, looking at how AI can be used for good, and giving advice and guidance that empowers people to use AI safely and responsibly.
