Here is a 'programme' for the Year 6's last term at Stratford

Trip to London

On **Tuesday 30th June** Year 6 will visit London for the day! We will visit two museums – Victoria & Albert (V&A) and the Science Museum. In the morning, we will visit the V&A to view the various pieces of art and artefacts. In the afternoon, we will cross the road to visit the Science Museum. Here, we will see some of the different exhibitions in the museum as well as experience the 'Wonder Show'.

We will travel to and from London by coach and tube. Please arrive at school at **07:15** so we can leave on the coach promptly at **07:30**. We hope to arrive at Richmond Train station by 10:00 to catch the tube to Gloucester Road (a 30-minute tube ride). Here we walk through to the V&A Museum (a 10-minute walk). On the way back the coach will collect us from the Science Museum. We will leave London at 15:30 and the coach company estimate our arrival time back at school will be **18:30** (depending on traffic!) On the way there and back, we have planned a stop at Fleet Service Station for a loo break!

Your child will need a packed lunch this day, enough to drink and an extra snack or two! **There are some children with nut allergies, please ensure your child's packed lunch is nut free.** If your child is eligible for a free school meal, please contact the office admin@stratford-sub-castle.wilts.sch.uk and a packed lunch will be provided for your child.

Please complete the consent form and make donation on ParentPay by Friday 12th June. The cost of the trip is £36 per child. We ask for a donation of £15 and the rest is kindly being funded by the FOSS. The default payment will be £36 but please adjust this to the amount you would like to pay.

End of Year show

Hoodies

Water Fight & Leavers' Celebration

The Year 6 pupils have been promised a water fight (optional participation), by Mrs Watkins, at the end of term. It will be after school on **Tuesday 21st July** followed by a leavers' celebration including families.

For the water fight, Year 6 need to bring to school (if they want to take part):

- clothes to get wet in, including a change of shoes, and some dry clothes to put on afterwards if they do not want to put their uniform back on
- towel
- hair brush / comb
- swimming costume

Year 6 may bring their own 'water pistol/gun' if they have one, there is no need to buy one if you don't have one... various receptacles will be available.

Families of year 6 pupils may arrive from 4:15pm and we will have pizza together. This will be followed by a family game of rounders. Please note this is for adults and Year 6 pupils only, not siblings.

School Leavers' Service

Leavers' Service on **Wednesday 22nd July** will be held in the Church. Doors to the church will be open following drop off at school and we will start the service as close to 09:00 as we can. Year 6 parents and families are invited.
