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PLANS FOR 2021/2022 (Please read carefully)

Dear All

Here are the plans (as they stand) for the beginning of 2021/2022. If anything changes during the summer break, I will contact you before the **first day of term on Thursday 2**nd **September 2021.**

The overall plan for next academic year is to be together as a whole school outdoors and mix a little bit more indoors. Moving towards full mixing indoors at some point! This will be reviewed regularly. This is not just about C-19 but also about making all transitions as easy as possible for the children. At first, we will not hold whole school assemblies indoors. We will see how this goes, then gradually re-introduce whole school assemblies/worship (indoors)... and then invite parents back in as well and gradually get back to 'normal'. Yeeeeeeeeeeeeeeeee.

Currently the plan is to make masks optional on the school site in September 2021. We are inviting people to use their own discretion on mask usage.



Drop-off and collection times will remain staggered in September 2021. We will monitor the effectiveness of this 'routine' and keep it under constant review.

ARRIVAL

Parents may come onto the school site but please say goodbye and leave as soon as possible. Please do not come into the buildings. We would encourage most people to drop at the gate, as we have been doing. If you are unable to stick to your allocated time (because it makes mornings difficult for your family), just get to school between 08:40 and 08:58... and have a calm start to the day!

Please arrive according to your child's surname.

08:40 = A to G

08:45 = H to N If you happen to be travelling/ arriving at school with someone with a different surname

08:50 = O to Z choose one time slot and arrive together. This is not a problem!

Children will go into school get their things sorted and then come back out to play on the field or the playground. Children will go into school get their things sorted and then come back out to play on the field or the playground. Reception (YR) children will stay in their outdoor area initially!

When dropping off children...

- Keep to allocated time slot, if you can!
- Drop-off at kerb if pupils are old enough or if younger, bring to gate or playground and 'hand-over' to staff
- Maintain and respect social distancing of adults.

Make sure you do not park on the zig-zag lines, bus stop or double yellow lines and take great care when pulling in and when you leave. <u>Take care of ALL OUR CHILDREN!</u> The Reading Room carpark is available! You may park and walk from there.

Pupils and staff will continue to...

- Use anti-bacterial gel on hands on entering the school/classroom
- Follow good respiratory hygiene. We have bins with lids to allow for *catch it, bin it, kill it!* Please teach your children to catch coughs and sneezes in a tissue, bin it and then wash their hands.

<u>COLLECTION – Please note we have reduced to two slots and all children should leave by 15:10 unless</u> they are staying for Night Owls

Meet up and leave the school site immediately according to your **child's surname**. Meet with the younger child first and we will steer you other children in the right direction.

15:00 - 15:05 = A to L

15:05 - 15:10 = M to Z

If you are travelling/leaving with someone who has a different surname please let us know. We will arrange for you to leave together.

At the end of the day, we all need to ...

- Exit using the using the main gate and adhere to the one way system
- Maintain and respect social distancing of adults.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

We are planning to start after school clubs a couple of weeks after returning in September. More details will follow the summer break.

THINGS TO REMEMBER AND BE AWARE OF...

Children need to bring:

- Snack and drinks for the day including a water bottle (named please- also note the water fountains are closed)
- PE kit (named in a named bag)
- Book bag for reading book (school will provide a clear plastic zipper if required).

Please do not provide your child with nuts for their snack or packed lunch as we do have children with nut allergies.

Other considerations:

- If possible, children should bring a small pencil case (Y3 Y6) so that we can minimize the sharing of equipment.
- Children may bring to school a small 'transition object', if it makes them feel more confident about coming in. Please don't bring anything too precious things do get lost and broken very occasionally!
- **NAME EVERYTHING** especially plastic snack boxes, coats and sweatshirts.
